Edinburgh Award (School Maths: Coaching)

This award is given to students whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a Maths Coach. These students have worked as paid Maths Coaches during the teaching semesters of the academic year, coaching school pupils online in mathematics over a bespoke platform where communication is entirely text and drawing based.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase awareness of their strengths;
- make the most of their strengths, identify areas for development, and work on a plan to develop these skills;
- confidently demonstrate what they have to offer to others;
- achieve a positive and lasting impact; and
- look not only at their role as a Maths Coach, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a Maths Coach, and *vice versa*.
